



## MASINO CASTLE, AGLIE' CASTLE, TASTING ERBALUCE WINE AND STARRED MICHELIN DINNER

In the late morning departure from Turin to the Candia Lake area, well known and important natural oasis of the Canavese land. Visit of one of the excellent local wine producer, tasting his wines Erbaluce and Passito accompanied by local cheeses as a light lunch. In the afternoon short transfer to visit the charming Masino Castle, built in the 11<sup>th</sup> century, absolutely well preserved, with its remarkable hall and rooms, the gardens and the St. Charles Borromeo's Chapel where the first king of Italy was buried. Start on to transfer the Ducal Castle of Agliè, one of the most important Savoy's Residences in Piedmont, built in the 12<sup>th</sup> century and well restored during the 17<sup>th</sup> century by the main Savoy architect, Amedeo di Castellamonte. During spring and summer visit of the magnificent gardens and the large park. At the end of the day transfer to one of the best starred Michelin restaurant in Piedmont for the dinner. Back to Turin and overnight.

N.B. It's possible to enjoy the overnight stay in an historical and elegant Piedmontese mansion nearby.
